In December 2023, Securitas became the first global security solutions company to have its climate targets validated, committing to a substantial reduction of its emissions, and taking action to limit global warming to 1.5°C.
- Transparently reporting climate-related financial risks.
- Actively working toward achieving net-zero emissions by 2050.

Another industry-leading initiative – led by the Securitas Technology business – aims at promoting environmentally sustainable solutions in the electronic security sector. As part of the initiative, Securitas Technology now incorporates greenhouse gas emissions data into new
